Dear Parents/Carers

As we draw to the end of the school term, I am writing to inform you of some exciting events we have planned for all students and information regarding return to school in the New Year.

In the last week of term, all students will be involved in House Achievement Assemblies, where celebrations for attendance, achievement and participation will be recognised. This has been one of our big drives since returning in September and it is important, we recognise and reward our students who simply do as they should each and every day by demonstrating the Oakwood Student values.

On the last day of term, we are having an adjusted timetable allowing students to watch our annual Oakwood's Got Talent show. For this event to happen, we are running the school day slightly differently with a 45-minute brunch served mid-morning. All students who receive free school meal will still do so during the brunch sitting. A reminder that all students finish school at **1pm on Wednesday 21**<sup>st</sup> **December.** 

As we look to January can I remind all parents/carers that we return to school on **Wednesday 4th** January – all students should be on site at **8:40am**.

I am delighted to announce that from Monday 9<sup>th</sup> January we will be extending our breakfast provision and **all** students will be able to receive a **free breakfast** in the dining room between 8am and 8.35am. More details will follow soon but we anticipate many families taking us up on this great offer.

Please ensure that your child is prepared to return to school with full school uniform and full equipment. Following a school holiday, especially the Christmas break, we often see a spike in students wearing jewellery and/or make-up plus other elements of their appearance that is not allowed such as false nails, false eye-lashes etc. Please ensure your child returns to school in an appropriate manner following the school uniform policy so we can start the new year in a positive way.

I would like to remind all parents of our communication strategy with home. We have invested a lot of money in setting up the Class Charts platform. This will, in time, become our principle method of communicating with parents. Thank you to all parents, and students, who have already accessed and are using the Class Charts app to receive regular updates regarding their child/ren. If you haven't yet accessed it please do so ASAP and contact school if you need support in doing so.

A reminder to all parents that if you contact school you need to explain the reason for the call to our reception staff so they can direct your call appropriately. We have an escalation process and in most cases your message will be directed to your child's form tutor in the first instance. In addition, please don't come to school without a pre-booked appointment. Staff are extremely busy and will be unavailable to speak to you if you arrive at school with no notice.



Finally, can I remind you of the importance of attending school every day and being punctual both at the start of the day and between lessons. Recent Year 11 examination results and forecast grades for the current year 11 students show that those students who attend school **over 90%** of the time achieve on average **two grades better** than their peers who are persistently absent from school (below 90% attendance). We expect all students to be in school every day and strive for all students to have over 95% attendance. We appreciate your support in this matter.

Thank you for all of your support during the first academic term of the year and on behalf of all staff at The Oakwood Academy I wish you a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.
