You'll then need to show good understanding in the following A/A* topics...

Its not guaranteed that all these topics will appear, that's why the grade D, C and B questions are so important.

*However, many of these **will** appear in one of your exam papers and they are usually worth 4 marks or more.*

Remember...

- For an A grade you need to be looking at 140 marks over both papers.
- For an A* you need to looking around the 160 mark.
