MATHS

The department comprises six full-time and one part-time member of staff and is situated in six classrooms, with all rooms benefiting from projectors, visualisers and interactive whiteboards. Maths is a popular subject in the school, and results have followed an upward trend in recent years. The department follows the AQA specification at GCSE (code 8300).

At Key Stage 3 we follow the Redhill Trust scheme of learning, with a special emphasis on the Mastery curriculum. The scheme of learning is fluid and encourages the use of a wide and varied range of resources and teaching materials to help support pupil progress, as well as to enable enquiry-based learning.

The GCSE course starts in Year 9 and also uses the Redhill Trust model. This allows for consistent assessments and interventions across Trust schools. Students have 4 hours of Maths lessons per week and in Y11 those students requiring extra support take part in small-group intervention sessions.

Maths forms a key component in any school and hence the successful candidate will play a crucial part in continuing to build on the successes of both the Maths department and the school as a whole.
