PE

The department comprises two full-time and three part-time members of staff and is situated in state of the art facilities. Practical areas consist of a multi use games area, hard courts, sports hall, a multi gym and extensive fields that provide direct access into Bestwood Country Park. Our teaching rooms all benefit from projectors, visualisers and interactive whiteboards. PE is a popular subject in the school with various teams and clubs bringing much success and enrichment to our students. GCSE PE is a popular course at KS4 with results demonstrating an upward trend in recent years. The department follows the OCR specification at GCSE.

Core PE at KS3 and 4 follow the Redhill Trust schemes of learning, with the vision of providing experiences for our students across a range of sports to aid skill development and a love of the subject.

The GCSE option course starts in Year 9 and also uses the Redhill Trust model. This allows for consistent assessments and interventions across Trust schools. Students have 5 hours of GCSE PE lessons per fortnight with those students requiring extra support benefitting from additional departmental intervention sessions.

PE forms a key component in any school and hence the successful candidate will play a crucial part in continuing to build on the successes of both the PE department and the school as a whole.
