SCIENCE

The department comprises six full-time and one part-time member of staff and is situated in six classrooms, with all rooms benefiting from projectors, visualisers and interactive whiteboards. Science is a popular subject in the school, and results have followed an upward trend in recent years. The department follows the AQA Combined Science (8464) and Separate Science specifications at GCSE.

The departments works under the leadership of the Head of Faculty, as well as subject co-ordinators at Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4. Common schemes of learning, resources and assessments are in place, and the department works closely with the Trust Director of Science.

The GCSE course starts in Year 9 and uses the Redhill Trust model. This allows for consistent assessments and interventions across Trust schools. Students have 5 hours of Science lessons per week and in Y11 those students requiring extra support take part in small-group intervention sessions.

Science forms a key component in any school and hence the successful candidate will play a crucial part in continuing to build on the successes of both the Science department and the school as a whole.
